Other than direct aid for Adult Day, the most important element for the next federal COVID relief legislation may well be increasing the share of Medicaid funds the Federal government applies to match state Medicaid funds. In short, enhancing the Federal Medicaid Assistance Percentage or FMAP.

- Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, state budgets are experiencing significant shortfalls.
