



Board Member Requirements

The following will be required of Board Member of the National Adult Day Services Association:

- Attend two in-person Board meetings (Spring Board Retreat and pre-NADSA National Conference Board Meeting), the NADSA National Conference and four-to-six additional virtual Board meetings annually. The spring in-person Board Retreat takes place in the same city as the National Conference. In-person Board meetings and NADSA Conference require travel and conference registration at the Board Member's expense.
- Engage as a working member of at least one committee and/or task force and dedicate 2-4 hours per month to this committee or task force work.
- Assist in the promotion of NADSA professional development programs and events (e.g., National Conference, Boot Camps, and webinars).
- Be involved in soliciting sponsors/exhibitors and/or advertisers for the national conference.
- Represent NADSA with your state Adult Day Services association (if your state has an ADS Association) and /or other relevant state-level efforts impacting Adult Day Services.
- Have the financial capacity to make an annual personal contribution to NADSA (no set minimum amount).
